## Paranormal Scientific Investigators

### Rules, Guidelines & Protocol

As an agent of PSI (Paranormal Scientific Investigators) I hereby agree to obey all rules set forth by the founders of this organization during all investigations or anytime the group is being represented for any reason and understand that any misconduct could result in my dismissal. I also agree to the following statements:

1. We will always dress, act and conduct ourselves as trained professionals during all investigations or any time the group is being represented for any reason. This includes not using vulgar language while investigating. You must have the utmost respect towards the members, clients, media, or any other related individuals. Acting with a professional manner and polite attitude at all times is a must! In order to be taken seriously we must act seriously and not give people a reason to find any fault with this organization, it's team of researchers, and it's members. Membership will be revoked if a person is found to be acting in a negative or unprofessional manner towards or while representing this organization.
2. We will also always respect the property we are investigating including statues, monuments, furniture, cemeteries, buildings, etc...and will be left undisturbed.
3. We will not discuss any information gathered during an investigation with anyone outside of the investigation team unless written permission is granted by the property owner.
4. We will not harass (sexual or otherwise) other members of our organization or people associated with an investigation site. Inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated.
5. As a scientific organization all views and opinions of members and non-members will be respected.
6. No PSI member will knowingly take that which does not belong to him or her.
7. If any member takes medication (whether it is an over the counter drug or prescribed by a doctor) they are to notify a co-chair at the time of an investigation. No illegal drugs or alcoholic beverages are to be used at any time.
8. We understand that everyone has families and emergencies happen but we ask that cell phone use during an investigation be kept to a minimum.
9. Every member is required to participate in at least one-third of the investigations per quarter unless prior approval is granted from all co-chairs.
10. No member is allowed to use PSI logos or trademarks without written permission from PSI co-chairs.
11. All PSI members are to be required to be in pairs during all investigations. This is to insure a quality investigation and your safety. Never investigate alone.
12. No smoking on investigations as this may create false ecto-plasmic mist type pictures while photographing.
13. During outside investigations we will not take pictures in the rain, snow, high winds, or when fog may be present. They may create false anomalies to appear on pictures.
14. No trespassing or investigating on private property without written permission.
15. You must be extremely quiet when trying to capture electronic voice phenomena with the use of audio recording devices, with the exception of asking an entity a question or issuing it a command.
16. When going on an investigation do not wear strong smelling colognes or perfumes. Paranormal activity may sometimes be indicated by certain smells.
17. Seances or the use of ouija boards will not be used on our investigations.
18. Never run at any location. It could lead to damaging property or hurting yourself or others.
19. No member shall bring a guest to an investigation without prior approval from the director/team leader. Each investigation is planned out to include an X-number of members and extra people will only take away from an investigation. There are observer forms available and must be turned in at least 1 week prior to an investigation for consideration and sign by all founders.
